



**AJS DANCE**  
**COVID-19 CODE OF CONDUCT**  
**Seniors/Advanced**

This guide provides details of what is expected of you when you return to dance classes. This information delivers a **Code of Conduct** and you must read and agree to the **BEFORE** resuming lessons.

**You must strictly follow government requirements to self-isolate if you or a member of your household has any symptoms of suspected Coronavirus**

**Do not attend lessons if you have any symptoms of ill health, no matter how mild**

**You must ensure that you do not attend if you are required to self-isolate due to potential contact with the virus, even if you do not have the symptoms**

### **When at dancing**

Teachers and pupils are expected to act in a responsible manner at all times, which includes

- Being aware of the social distancing rules as far as possible
- Use hand sanitiser on arrival to the studio
- Do not share any of your personal items
- Be respectful of others around you
- Bring your own water and do not share

### **Toilet facilities**

- Pupils will only be able to leave the studio during lesson to use the toilet
- Make sure hands are washed for at least 20 seconds and dried on a disposable towel
- On return to the studio, re-sanitise your hands
- All other areas of the Royal school, including the café, are out of bounds

### **If you have any concerns**

- If you feel worried or anxious at any time speak with me or any of the teachers
- If you see someone not being responsible or respectful, you must report this, confidently, to me or any of the teachers

We care about your safety and that of the staff. So that we are able to continue with classes each pupil is requested to be conscious of the present situation we are in. By attending you agree to this code of conduct.



## COVID-19 RETURN TO LESSONS CHECK LIST

Please ensure that conversation has been had with each pupil on the returning to classes

Activity	Done
Ensure pupil is aware of and has agreed to the COVID-19 pupil code of conduct	
The pupil is aware of not roaming around the centre	
Pupils are aware that if they leave the studio, they repeat the hand sanitising on re-entry	
Pupils understand that if they develop any symptoms of COVID-19 whilst at dancing they must inform the principal and immediately leave the premises. They should then follow the Government guidelines with regard to self-isolation and testing	
Pupils made aware the if they develop symptoms which indicate COVID-19 or diagnosed with COVID-19 they must not attend classes and follow Government guidelines with regard to self-isolation and testing <b>They must inform the principal immediately</b>	
Pupils are aware that if a family member they live with or someone they have been in close contact with, develops symptoms or is diagnosed with COVID-19 they must not attend classes and follow the government guidelines with regard to self-isolation and testing. <b>They must inform the principal immediately</b>	
Pupil is aware they may be required to self-isolate if another student that they have been in close contact develops symptoms or is diagnosed with COVID-19
